NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS

All persons coming to the Department of Public Works Garage in Windsor Locks are required to check in at the office. Items will only be accepted from **RESIDENTS** of **WINDSOR LOCKS** and **ONLY from NON-COMMERCIAL SOURCES**. No items should be dropped off until they have been accepted by staff. Once items are accepted they are Town Property and should not be removed from the property for any reason. If recycling used motor oil, you are required to complete an affidavit every time. **Be prepared to show ID.**

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MAY be ACCEPTED

Covered Electronic Devices, Used Un-Mixed Motor Oil, Batteries, Anti-Freeze

EXCESS CARDOARD

Did you get new appliances, or move recently and find yourself with too much cardboard? **Take it to Babylon Recycling at 1221 Harvey Lane in Suffield.** The hours are 6am—3pm Monday thru Friday. There is no charge to deliver cardboard to Babylon.

PAINT RECYCLING

Paint is not accepted at the Public Works Garage. Sherwin Williams Stores in Enfield & East Hartford accept paint as part of a paint stewardship program. See the following website for more information, www.paintcare.org

WINTER NEWS

Salt is now available for RESIDENT use (no contractors). The salt shed is located at the second driveway. Bring your own shovel and bucket.

Snow Plowing and Sidewalk Clearing. It takes up to 6 hours **AFTER** it stops snowing to clear the roads. It is not legal to discharge snow from your property into the roads.

Mailboxes will not be repaired or replaced by Public Works unless **CONTACT was made** by a Town plow, not if the damage was caused by snow pushed onto the box or pole. Inspect and repair your mailboxes and poles before the storm season.

Christmas Tree Collections will begin the first week of January and end January 25, 2016. Place them near the end of your driveway away from sidewalks and driveway ends.

Adopt a Fire Hydrant. Fire Hydrants are not cleared by Public Works Crews. Work with your neighbors to help keep the fire hydrants clear in your neighborhood.

Trash Barrels and Basketball Hoops. Trash Barrels and Portable Basketball hoops are not allowed in the roadway. Articles placed in the road are dangerous to drivers and the public.
