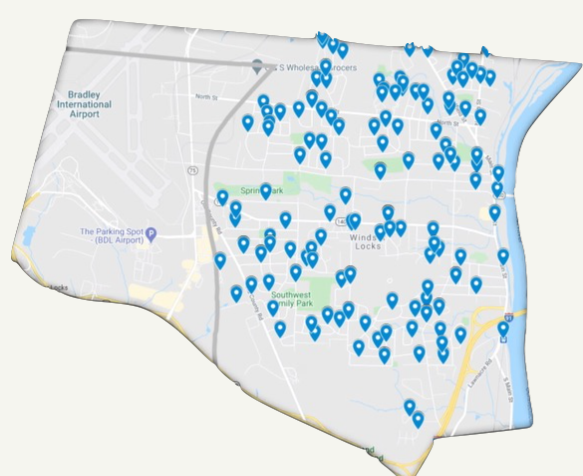


Windsor Locks COVID-19 Community Impact

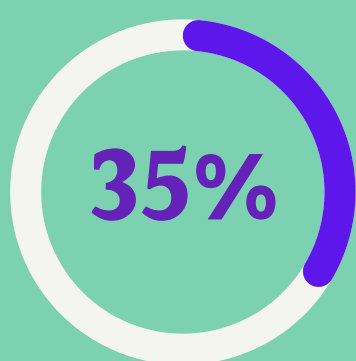

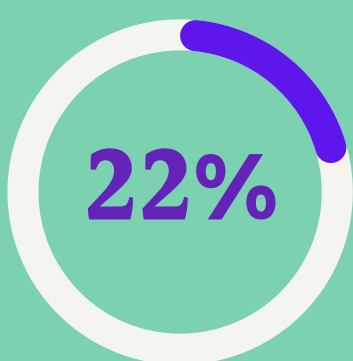
Respondents were invited to tell us which neighborhood they live in, and some did, so we mapped those locations. We received survey responses from all over town.



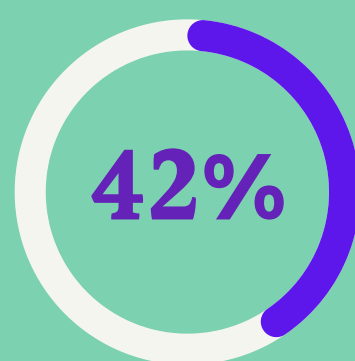
Of residents have **MENTAL HEALTH CONCERNS**. Including loneliness, isolation, increased stress, anxiety, and fear.



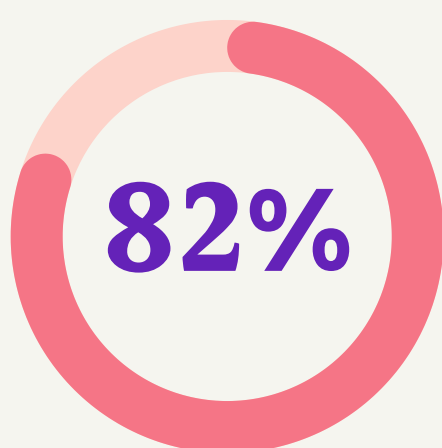
FINANCIAL IMPACTS
Including loss of employment and reduced income



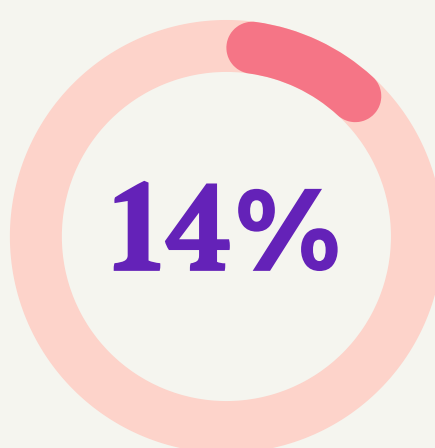
FOOD RESOURCES

Missing socialization, fun events, entertainment, outings, and worship.



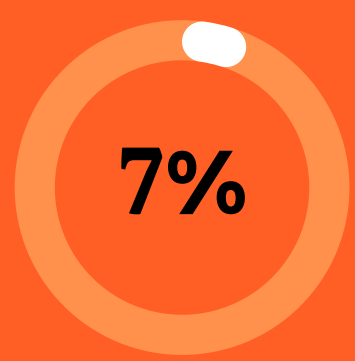
HOUSING INSECURITY
Trouble paying rent, fear of homelessness, can't make essential home improvements



CHILDCARE
Center closures, paying babysitter, can't work to stay home with child



TRANSPORTATION
Can't get to work or appointments, don't want to ride public transportation



SMALL BUSINESS
Loss of revenue, had to lay off workers or close shop
