I. Call to Order

a. The Honorable First Selectman Scott Storms, called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00PM in the Gymnasium located at the Windsor Locks Town Hall.

II. \$1,720,000 for the 2025 Roadway Infrastructure Improvements on Old County Road

- a. First Selectman Scott Storms introduced Public Works Director Phil Sissick, to speak about the Old County Road Infrastructure Improvements.
- b. Public Works Director Phil Sissick explained that Old County Road would be milled and paved from Halfway House Road to the Windsor line. There would also be some ADA repairs on sidewalks and some sewer repairs (catch basins).
- c. Resident Peggy Sayers (477 Denslow Street) asked how do we know the infrastructure underneath Old County Road is in good shape and we wont have to fix it?
- d. Public Works Director Phil Sissick explained how they haven't had any sewer issues on Old County Road except in one spot and it was fixed ten or fifteen years ago.
- e. Resident Eric Marsh (94 South Elm Street) asked if they looked into ways to calm the traffic and reduce speed.
- f. Public Works Director Phil Sissick discussed traffic calming paving markers and trying to get tractor trailer trucks to utilize route 20.
