### 4. Secretary's Report

### 5. Report of Officers

#### -Fire Marshal Report

- -15 inspections were performed during the month of November.
- -Annual inspections included a license inspection at the Blackboard Café. Five reinspections disclosed that all violations had been corrected.
- -As of November 30, 2024 there have been 220 inspections concluded in Fiscal Year 2025. Total inspections for the calendar year of 2024 are 538.
- -10 sets of plans were reviewed this period including mechanical and demo drawings for 41 and 30 Hamilton Road.
- -November 2024 revenues: \$1,880.00. 2025 Fiscal Year Revenues: \$26,045.00.
- -Calendar Year Revenues: \$90,234.00. FY 2024 Final Revenues: \$200,371.00

### Chief Report

- -During November there were 46 alarms and 3 drills. During May 2024 through November 2024, the Department responded to a total of 306 alarms and 14 drills. During the month of November, we responded to 5 calls in the TIF District, 3 Mutual Aid responses to our neighboring towns, 3 calls to I-91, received 3 mutual aid responses, 1 medical assist and 15 unauthorized burns.
- -Regular scheduled drills were held during the month. On November 26<sup>th</sup> we had a presentation on Photo Voltaic Safety for First Responders.
- -The overhead door by Engine 2 is not closing. Calls were made to DPW for help as directed. The company doing the repairs found that additional parts need to be ordered.
- -December 15<sup>th</sup> is the children's Christmas party.
